## General Rules

1. Full Dress Code, long sleeves, boots/heels down, cowboy hat or helmet all weekend, besides exhibitions. The only way to be 'out' of dress code is in Summer Classic attire.
2. W9 must be submitted before collecting any winnings. You can email one to [sierrasms@gmail.com](mailto:sierrasms@gmail.com)
3. All fees and winnings must be paid in US Funds.
4. Be respectful of each other and to our entire staff. No drama will be tolerated, only good vibes and encouragement.
5. Knocked over barrels or a broken pattern will be a 99.999/No Time.
6. One helper may assist in the alley way, but must be in and out of the alley by the time of the run is completed to help efficiently move to the next person.
7. Reruns will only be offered in the event of a timer malfunction. Reruns will not be given for horses falling, contestant's equipment breaking or for a rider's decision to pull up.
8. Official time will go off the timer box in front of the announcer, not the digital display in the arena.
9. No tuning of horses in the arena during the race is going on.
10. Zero Tolerance Policy Abuse includes but is not limited to excessive jerking, spurring, whipping, or any other act intended to cause trauma or injury to a horse in the arena, practice pen, or on grounds. Any accusations of abuse will be reviewed by the producer. Abusers will be asked to leave show grounds forfeiting any and all fees or winnings.
11. Contestants are highly encouraged to take proper care of horses by feeding, watering and taking care of horses while on the premises. We will be monitoring and neglectful owners will be asked to leave with no refunds of any kind.
12. Onsite entries, will take check, cash, card and pending more payment options.

13. Checks made payable to **The Expo at Glen Rose** if mailing entries in.
14. Youth eligibility riders are based on what grade they are going IN to. Incoming seniors and under are youth. If a contestant is heading TO college or has graduated high school, they are NOT youth eligible.
15. **Incentive Sidepots - Side Pots throughout the entire weekend - 1 Payout, 80% Payback** - Any side pots can be added onto your entry on site! Must notify the office prior to running. One payout for each incentive/sidepot over the entire weekend. You can enter each incentive/sidepot each time you run down the alley.
16. Contestants may only 'roll' times into a sidepot. If you choose to run 3 days, but only enter a sidepot one time - it will automatically go to the 1st run the contestant made that weekend unless stated otherwise (Must say before you run). You may pay into the sidepot as many times as you enter the open!
17. There is no rolling an open time into another day. This is one race over 3 days, where you may run

### TRAILER KEY WINNERS

The top 3 in EACH D in the Open, Youth and BOTH Slot Races will get a key. If we pass 1000 open entries for the week, the Open will extend to the top 5 of each D to get keys. SOMEONE must be present to collect a key for each key winner, to be eligible to win it. Due to the lengthy weekend schedule, we will allow others to step in for the winner. The actual trailer winner MUST BE PRESENT to pick up the trailer.

### Sidepots

A sidepot must have 8 entries to be able to 'D' it. If a sidepot does not reach 8 entries, it will be rodeo/straight pay. A sidepot can be added to EACH of your runs. For example, if you choose to enter once on Friday, once on Saturday, and once on Sunday, you may enter the sidepot three times for each run. If you only choose to enter the sidepot ONCE, you must nominate which run you want the sidepot to PRIOR to running. It will not be given to the best run. If it is not chosen, the producer will nominate the first run of the weekend to be where the sidepot is given.

Heroes sidepot is anyone who works in a career that is deemed positive to mental health services, or who is considered a high risk job affecting mental health. Some examples are military, first responder, doctor, lawyer, chiropractor, teacher, counselor, and more.

Highstakes is a 2D sidepot with a half second split.

Youth is a 3D sidepot with a 1 second split. Incoming senior and lower is the age group.

Futurity is a 2D sidepot with a .75 second split.

Derby is a 2D sidepot with a .5 second split.

Adult is a 3D sidepot with a .5 second split. 18-49 is the age group.

WPRA is a rodeo payout sidepot with \$250 added.

PBRIP is a sidepot with \$250 added.

Paint is a regular paint sidepot, 3D with .5 second split.

Senior is a 3D sidepot with 1 second split, 50 and older is the age group.

## **Slot Races**

Slot races will be ran together to help avoid running in the heat of the day. Youth may enter both slot race on one horse. They can choose to roll over or run that horse twice and let the producer know which run will be for the open and which run will be for youth prior to running. Contestants may enter multiple horses in the slot race, and the slot race can be rolled into the open and sidepots for that day as well.

## **Draw Outs**

You may get a refund, minus the office fee with no stipulation by July 26th. No refunds will be given after that date, unless you have a vet or doctor draw out. You may sell exhibitions, and must inform producers. If not informed, contestants will be charged an additional office fee. Producer will make the call for selling spots, or what is done with numbers for any draw outs. If you have any questions, 817 825 8381 is the Arrow CS Productions work cell phone number.

## **Exhibitions**

- a. Sold online beginning July 1st
- b. 29 exhibitions per time slot.
- c. Check in at the back gate.
- d. Exhibitions must be kept under 60 seconds or you will be fined \$10 for every 60 seconds you go over, and must be paid prior to you competing.

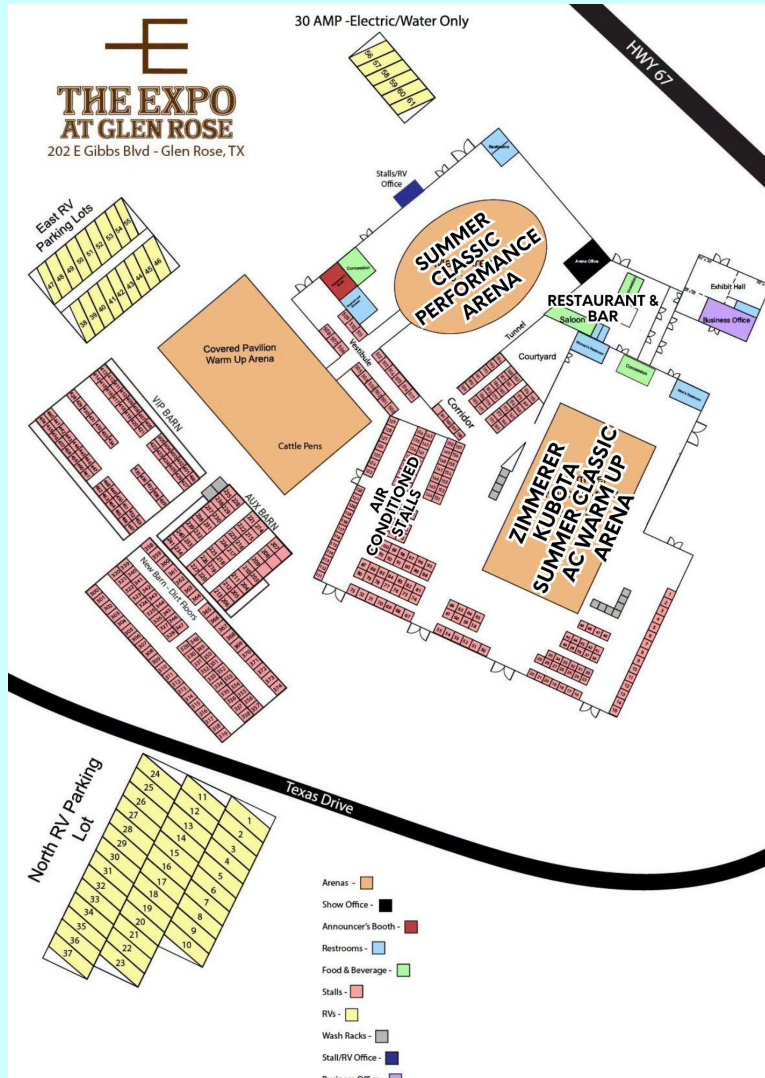
## **Facility Layout**

We will use the right gate to enter the arena, very long alley - works good for a left or right horse.

No closed gate at the end of the alley, will be run to the corner of the back covered warm up area.

The next 20 horses will be allowed in the back warm up pen. All others warming up will be in the Zimmerer Kubota arena next door.

There will be a small holding pen for the next 5 runners, or the next drag. Be ready when your name is called, or you have a chance at being turned out. Kayla will be our gate queen for the weekend, so be ready to say hi!
